



TERMINATION OF THE PRESIDENT'S CONTRACT

PURPOSE AND RATIONALE

Hiring and assigning the President is for the benefit of the University. The President is the chief executive officer of the University and is responsible for the overall management and administration of the University.

DIRECTIVE, REQUIREMENT, PROCEDURE, STANDARDS, GUIDELINES, FORMS

1. Terminating the President's Contract

A contract is entered into between the University and the President. The contract is for a fixed term and is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the contract. The contract is terminated upon the expiration of the term or upon the occurrence of any of the events specified in the contract.

1. The Board of Regents may terminate the contract of the President if it finds that the President is unable to perform his or her duties or if the President is guilty of any act of moral turpitude.
2. The Board of Regents may terminate the contract of the President if the President is convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude.
