

TO BECOME A DECISTEDED AUDSE)

The BSN Program is a competitive entry program and SIP <u>does not</u> have any reserved seats for incoming students, unlike other programs. However, students can take dual credit courses during their Grade 12 year which are part of the BSN program.

This program carries a heavy academic load with seven courses being required in both Term 1 and Term 2. For students to enter the program having one (or more) courses already completed the program.

Options include:

English 15 (Inormally taken in Term 1 of the BSN program).

- o Pre-req is a C+ in Eng 12, or assessment. Call SIP to discuss
- IST 12@normally taken in Term 2 of the BSN program)
 - o Pre-req is a Cin Eng 11
